Dear Ms. Coffey:

This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, dated May 28, 2010, for information relating to the Final Public Tours at Indian Lakes Wild Horse Facility.

In accordance with our letter dated, June 22, 2010, we have enclosed your first installment of documents. In this installment, we are releasing approximately 234 pages of responsive documents in their entirety. The enclosed documents respond to Item numbers 1, 5, 7 and 8 of your request.

The following is in response to Item numbers 1, 3, 4, 7 and 8. In reference to Item number 1, there are no meeting notes or telephone records pertaining to the decision to close Indian Lakes to the public. Also in reply to Item 1, there is also no list of employees who participated in this decision. In response to Item number 3, there is no itemized list or record of the amount of money spent on the "unplanned costs." In response to Item number 4, there is no list or record of staff who were detailed to work at the Indian Lakes Facility away from their priority work.

In reference to Item numbers 7 and 8, the Daily Indian Lakes Wild Horse Facility/Veterinary Reports are provided for January 26, 2010 through April 23, 2010. Prior to January 26, animal health and treatment records along with animals that died or were euthanized were provided to the public on the BLM Nevada's Wild Horse and Burro webpage at: www.blm.gov/nv/st/en/fo/wfo/blm_programs/wild_horses_and_burros/calico_mountains_complex/gather_activity_updates.html. During the period of April 23, 2010 until May 1, 2010, no Daily Indian Lakes Wild Horse Facility/Veterinary Reports were created due to the lack of BLM personnel on staff. However, this information can be located on the internet site listed above along with weekly updates through August 2010. The Bureau's response to the remaining items in your request will be answered in the next release.
